Pre-K Giraffe News

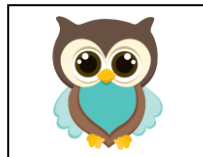
Hi Giraffe Families,

Hi Butterfly Families,

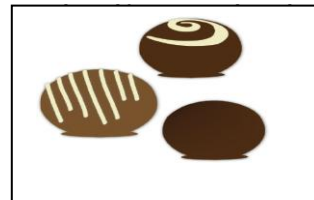
