Ingredients:

I lbs. elbow noodles, ½ cup salted butter, ½ cup flour, 2 tbs crushed garlic, 4 cups milk, 4 cups shredded cheddar blend cheese, I tsp salt, I tsp pepper Instructions:

Boil water in large pot. Add noodles when water is ready. Cook al dente. In another pot, cook butter and garlic on low until melted, add flour, salt and pepper. Mix until consistency is like sand. Slowly add milk and stir until thoroughly combined, then add cheese. Mix until smooth. Strain elbow pasta from water and add back into pot. Pour cheese mixture over and combined. Add to baking dish and add cheese on top. Cook in oven at 350 until golden brown. ENJOY! ©
