Ingredients:


I lb. lean ground beef, 2 (16 oz) cans chili beans, 1 (16 oz) can tomato sauce, taco seasoning and onion powder to taste, 1 lb. elbow pasta, shredded cheese Instructions:



Cook lean ground beef in skillet until thoroughly cooked, add taco seasoning and onion powder. Boil elbow noodles until al dente, drain from water. Add meat, beans and tomato sauce to elbow pasta. Mix thoroughly. Add everything into a baking pan and top with cheese. Bake at 350 until cheese is melted. Serve hot.

Duckling Details


Hello Duckling families,
