INGREDIENTS: 3 CUPS WHITE RICE 1 80Z CAN TOMATO SAUCE 16 0Z MILD PACE SALSA 1 LB GROUND BEEF 1 TBS MINCED GARLIC 1 TSP PEPPER 1 PACKET TACO SEASONING 8 0Z BAG CHEDDAR CHEESE



DIRECTIONS: I. COOK RICE ON STOVE TOP OR IN RICE COOKER.

2. IN A LARGE SKILLET OVER MEDIUM-HIGH HEAT, BROWN THE GROUND BEEF. ADD GARLIC, TACO SEASONING AND PEPPER TO MEAT. SIMMER FOR 15 MIN.

3. COMBINED COOKED RICE AND TOMATO SAUCE, SALSA, MIX WELL.

4. LAYER RICE, MEAT AND CHEESE.

5. BAKE IN OVEN AT 350 UNTIL CHEESE IS MELTED AND SERVE HOT.
